## 2011 MILLCREEK OPEN ERIE PA OCT. 22-23, 2011 By Sam Steiner

Some new faces attended this year's installment of the Millcreek Open possibly related to our major reversal of the schedule, moving Sunday's events to Saturday and vice versa. This allowed a different set of players the benefit of getting home late after playing, and not having to get up sore to go to work. Except for Dave French.

The York power team of Wetzler and Burnside made short work of the U2400 and Senior Over 40 fields meeting in the finals of both. In both cases they elected to split the prize money having played enough times at home.

A strong Open draw culminated in the Final Four round robin of Dan & Randy Seemiller, Samson Dubina, and Joe Cochran. Spectators expected some sparks and got them. First up were 1<sup>st</sup> & 3<sup>rd</sup> seeds Dubina



and Dan Seemiller. The years have slowed Dan's game somewhat but he still has the wherewithal to compete on Samson's level. With Samson attacking on both sides and Dan mainly blocking and countering they traded fierce points and games back and forth into the deciding 7<sup>th</sup> game where they played even point for point to Dubina up 10-8. Then 10-9 with Dan serving. Then at this climactic moment...Dan serves into the net, to a concerted groan from the audience. Later after shaking it off Dan recounted that that was the 2<sup>nd</sup> time in his career that he did that- the last time being in 1980. But who's counting. Next Randy Seemiller, playing stronger than in his last Erie visit, was able get 2 games from Samson. Then Dan vs. his former student Joe Cochran. Again this was a close, fiercely contested battle culminating in a win for Cochran at 11-7 in the 7<sup>th</sup> game. This set up the climactic match for 1<sup>st</sup> & 2<sup>nd</sup> between the top seeds Cochran and Dubina. This was a slugfest of topspin but Joe acknowledged not being on top of his game after a 4-1 victory for Samson.

Some other notable play included strong play by the Pech brothers Seth & Keith, both seeming to take their game to the next level possibly due to Samson's coaching influence. Keith reached the semi's of 2200, the <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>'s of 2400, and 1<sup>st</sup> place in the Top Gun event. Seth reached the <sup>1</sup>/<sub>4</sub>'s of Open with wins over Chip Coulter and Don Hamilton, and had the wisdom not to push his now-recovered



shoulder after an injury several months ago. Toronto's Chandru Krishnan had some good wins and some near wins against strong players making the semi's of 2200 and 1/4's of 2400. Tak Cheong Ip of Cleveland was on fire to win the 2200's taking out the sandbagging Wetzler in the semi's and Keith Pech in the finals. New to U.S. table tennis was Asaf Azarsky presently living in Pittsburgh. Asaf plays a strong 2200+



chopping game but he had the misfortune to get knocked out of two events by Wetzler's power loops. Meijun Cai, born in China, raised in Jamaica, and now living in Utica, belied his 2001 rating losing to Wetzler in the 2200's 15-13 in the 5<sup>th</sup>.
